












# Donning and Doffing Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

(materials attributed to the Sunshine Coast Hospital and Health Service)

DONNING PPE		
Don PPE in the following order outside the patient's room ensuring compliance with hand hygiene		
DONNING: ORDER OF PPE APPLICATION	1. Perform Hand hygiene 	
	2. Put on long sleeve gown 	
	3. Put on mask and fit check 	
	4. Put on goggles 	
	5. Perform hand hygiene 	
	6. Put on gloves 	
7. Enter the patient's room. If a door handle or curtains are touched by the gloved hands on the way into the room, staff need to doff their gloves, perform hand hygiene and don a new set of gloves. Use elbows to open doors / curtains		
DOFFING PPE		
Commence doffing PPE whilst in the patient's room (by the exit door) or ante room		
DOFFING: ORDER OF PPE REMOVAL	1. Remove gloves and place in bin 	
	2. Perform hand hygiene 	
	3. Remove gown and place in bin 	
	4. Perform hand hygiene 	
	5. Exit the patient's room or remain in anteroom before doffing the remainder of PPE	
	6. Remove goggles and place in bin 	
	7. Perform hand hygiene 	
	8. Remove mask and place in bin 	
	9. Perform hand hygiene
